practices and processes and implements robust, cost effective and transparent CD solutions and services to satisfy assured information sharing requirement and achieve mission goals.

CD Community Goals

- 1) Ensure secure, robust and flexible CD capabilities are available and extensible to share information among a wide range of mission partners.
- 2) Ensure that CD technological developments are timely, responsive, and aligned with transformational initiative.
- 3) Ensure CD investments fill capability gaps, minimize redundant activities, increase efficiency and support the timely migration to the CD Baseline and Enterprise Services. The CD Community Roadmap V1.0 was published on 13 June 2008

The CD Community Roadmap is composed of the Vision, Goals, Objectives, Activities, Tasks and Metrics.

CD Community Objectives

Objective #1

Migrate the CD Community to Enterprise Services or Baseline Solutions.

Objective #2

Ensure the effective and efficient use of CD resources.

Objective #3

Align CD capability and technology development with the near, mid and long term information sharing needs of the IC and DoD

Objective #4

Ensure CD Policy supports information sharing goals of the Community and keeps pace with the emerging technology and architectures

What is the CD Community Roadmap?

The CD Community Roadmap sets the vision and direction for the Cross Domain community in the near, mid, and long-term timeframes.

How was the CD Community Roadmap developed?

The UCDMO Plans & Resources Division is responsible for the creation and maintenance of the Roadmap. Multi-agency participation and input contributed to the development of the document.



How will the CD Community Roadmap be updated?

CD Community Roadmap V1.0 was published by the UCDMO on 13 June 2008. A second version of the Roadmap is anticipated for late April 2009. Subsequently, the

UCDMO plans annual releases of the Roadmap in spring of each year to coincide with program planning and budgeting cycles.

Who is the CD Community?

(U) The CD Community consists of all elements of the IC/DoD with systems or requirements to communicate across or between multiple security domains. As a practical matter, this means the CD Community consists of all IC Agencies plus all DoD Components (Combatant Commands, Services, and Agencies). Note that selected executive branch departments contain components that are in the IC, but the departments as a whole are not (e.g., Departments of Justice, State, Homeland Security, Energy, and Treasury).
